PRACTICE DIRECTION CRIMINAL-12 Designation of Counsel

A designation of counsel pursuant to s. 650.01 of the *Criminal Code* shall be in the Designation of Counsel form.

Where a designation is filed, counsel, or counsel appearing on that counsel's behalf, may appear and act for the accused for all proceedings where the accused's presence is not required by law or the direction of a judge.
