PRACTICE DIRECTION GENERAL-4

Filing of Copies of Documents

- 1. The filing of copies of documents (as opposed to original documents) will continue to be permitted on the implied undertaking of the party or their counsel that they:
 - (a) will not file the copy of the document until they have made arrangements to promptly obtain the original; and
 - (b) will promptly file the original upon its receipt.
- 2. With the approval of the Clerk of the Court (or the Deputy Clerk) and subject to his/her direction, a party or their counsel may file pleadings or other documents with the Court by faxing them to the Court Registry, upon the implied undertaking that the original will be filed as soon as possible afterwards.
