Position of Counsel in Courtroom

In all criminal matters heard in Whitehorse, defence counsel shall sit at the counsel table closest to the door which connects the courtroom with the cell area. Crown counsel shall sit at the table closest to the witness stand.

For court circuits, Crown counsel shall sit at the table closest to the witness, subject to any limitations with the space being used or the direction of the presiding judge.

Counsel wishing to change this placement should seek the leave of the Court.
